What is Scrip?

Scrip is another name for gift cards or gift certificates. You buy a gift card for a store you shop at, at face value. The school purchases them from a scrip supplier at a reduced cost. The difference in cost is our profit. Example: You give Regina Coeli School a check for \$100, you receive \$100 gift card to Stop & Shop. The school makes \$4. Easy.

What stores are included?

They are listed on the order form and include Stop & Shop, Shop Rite, Macys, Home Depot, Molloy Pharmacy, Adams, Amish Market, T.J Maxx, Exxon/Mobil, Dunkin Donuts, Old Navy and many more! The order form may be downloaded at any time from the school website, or available at school. More retailers are listed at www.glscrip.com.

How can I participate?

You can buy scrip after any Regina Coeli Mass or send in an order form to school. Most orders will be filled within the week. Make checks payable to Regina Coeli School. Cards will be sent home with your oldest child or be available at the school or Church for pickup. Families are encouraged to bring in outside orders from friends and family—please combine all orders onto one form, separate checks are okay.



How can I help lower my tuition with SCRIP?

Through RCS's **Tuition Reimbursement Incentive Program (T.R.I.P.)**: For every dollar you spend RCS receives a percentage back from the vendor. Your family will receive 50% of that profit in the form of tuition reimbursement for next year! Last year SCRIP brought in over \$12,000 to the school and dozens of families earned a tuition reimbursement. See the school website for more details.

**An average of \$350 in scrip a month per family, the school would profit over \$21,000 in a year!
