What is Scrip?

Scrip is another name for gift cards or gift certificates. You buy a gift card for a store you shop at, at face value. The school purchases them from a scrip supplier at a reduced cost. The difference in cost is our profit. Example: You purchase a \$100 gift card for Stop & Shop. Stop & Shop gives 4% back, thus RCS makes \$4.00 on the sale.

What stores are included?

They are listed on the order form and include local vendors like Adams, Hannaford, Shop Rite, Exxon/Mobil, Molloy's, Coco's, Kohl's, J.C. Penney, Old Navy and many more! For a complete list visit the website: www.glscrip.com.

How can I participate?

You can purchase Scrip after all Masses at Regina Coeli/St. Paul. If you wish, you can send in an order form to school. Orders received by Monday noon will be filled and returned home via the oldest child that day. If there is scrip for a vendor we need to order, your order will be completed and sent home on Thursday. Orders that come in on other days will be filled on Monday or Thursday depending upon when received and inventory in the Scrip box. We also take "standing orders" for those who request cards for particular vendors on a regular basis. Just make your request known via a standing orders scrip form (found on the school website) and indicate when you need the card(s). Families are encouraged to bring outside orders from friends and family and combine the orders on one form. Separate checks are okay.

How can I help lower my tuition with SCRIP?

Through RCS's **Tuition Reimbursement Incentive Program (T.R.I.P.)**: For every dollar you spend, a percentage is returned by the vendor. When your account reaches \$50.00 you qualify to have 50% of that profit be returned to you in the form of tuition reimbursement for the next school year. For example: Family Z's purchases amounted to \$240.00 in profit. That family has reached the \$50.00 level and qualifies for \$120.00 Tuition Reimbursement off the next year's tuition bill. This past year, Scrip brought in over \$13,000 and dozens of school families earned over \$3,000 in tuition benefits.

How Is This a Win-Win Situation?

By purchasing Scrip to pay for items that you are planning to purchase – food, gas, clothing, etc., you are earning TRIP credit while providing a systemic funding source for the school. The more families that participate, the more return comes to the school, the more we can provide funding to build programs and operation.
