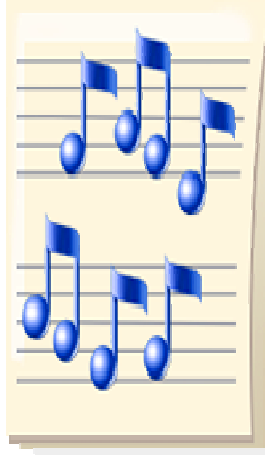
Spring Concert Notes
