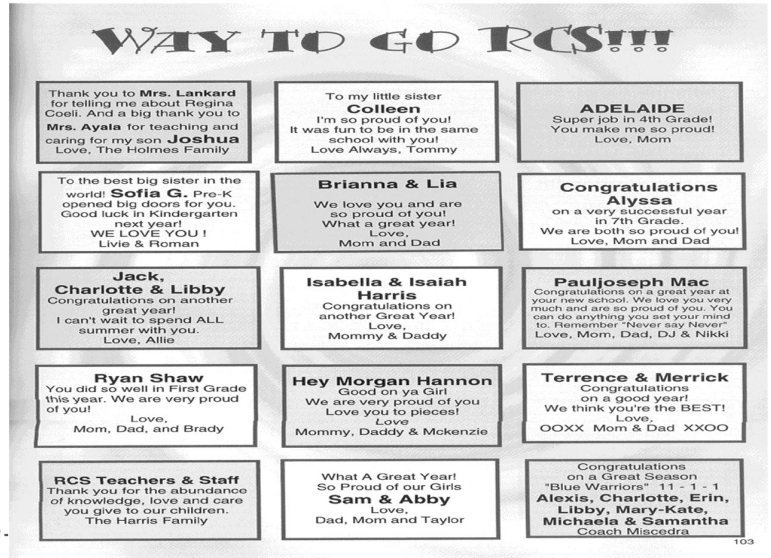
Send a "Shout Out" to your RCS student in this year's Yearbook
