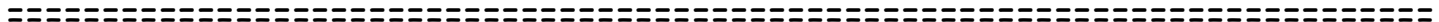
This is a tremendous opportunity for David and one that bespeaks a special talent. He will be leaving for Rome in a few weeks where he must remain for at least two years before returning home.
